- Duration of the Project: April 01, 2012 to May 31, 2013
- A Replication of the Republic/Democratic of Congo (Mapping)

Objectives of the Project

- 1- Increase capacity amongst women's right organizations, relevant service providers and legal support groups to use ICTs to document, report and track responses to incidences of VAW
- 2- Establish evidence to meeting stated goals on addressing VAW
- 3- Increase general awareness of VAW and the effectiveness/lack of effectiveness of responses to victims and survivors
- 4- Advocate for improved support and prevention responses to VAW

Project Scope

- Database establishment on GBV
 - Collection of GBV data
 - Mapping the GBV data
 - National resources: laws and policies
 - Testimony etc.
- Enhancing capacity of NLC/S, CCWC to use ICT to monitor GBV (access to and use template to report when VAW occurs in their commune/sangkat)
- Targeted area for survey
 - Phnom Penh
 - Kompong Thom
 - Siem Reap
 - Battambang(500 Communes/Sangkats are chosen to be surveyed)

The Progress of Implementation

- Determine the GBV in accordance with MoWA's
 - Physical violence: Striking, punching, pushing, pulling, slapping, whipping, kicking, tripping, kneeing, strangling, burning, throwing acid etc.
 - Psychological violence: Verbal aggression, yelling, cursing, insulting...
 - Financial violence: Deprivation of money/property
 - Sexual violence: Rape, molestation, harassment.

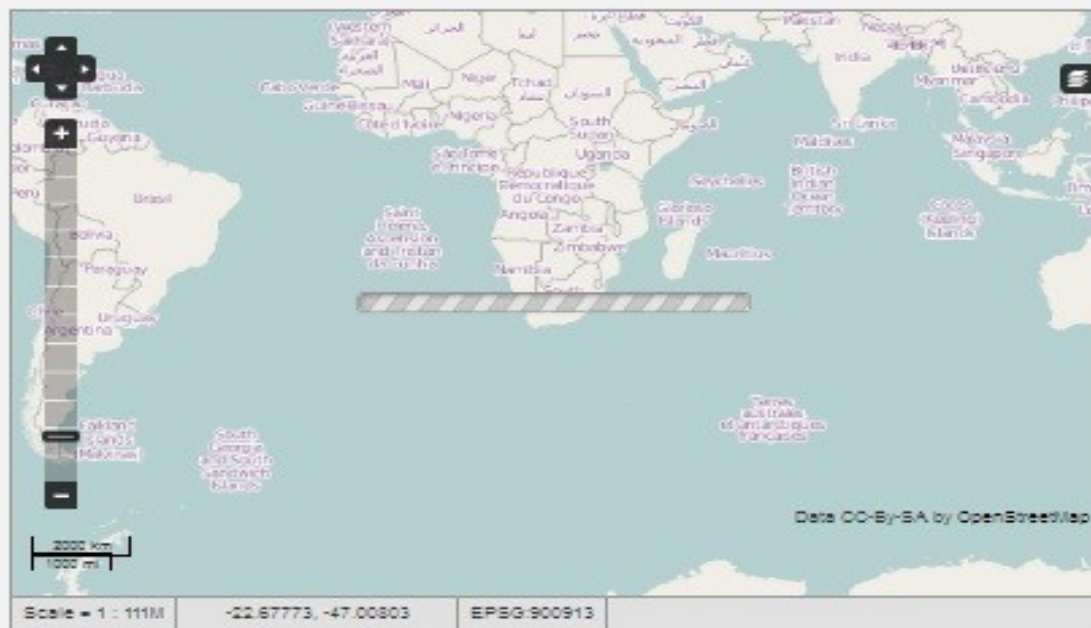
