CHALLENGE AND LESSONS LEARNT (CON...)

Lesson learnt

- Lack of youth's participate who are related to democracy issue on election process, good governance...
- Lack of communicate between young people and stakeholders on election information and good governance
- Lack of capacity related to ICT information, social network among commune council members
- Lack of social environment to support young people involve in political process.
- Increase project side (target areas and target population)
- Some activities should be reach to young people in the community (out of school youth)

BEST PRACTICES

- The project has built good relationship with MoWA, MoEYS, NEC, PEC, local authority, and university partners
- Strong to supported from local authority and University partners
- Young people a like to received the information about election and committed to share with friends and other young people.
- Young people commit to work as volunteers as inspector during promotion and election (NEC, PEC, SEC, other NGOs)
- Debate activity is the best of advocacy tools for young people participation, freedom of expression their right related to democracy, politic (election), and good governance.
